Kady's school is a junior high school¹. It has four buildings with three classrooms each, one office for the principal², a staff room where teachers meet, a small library with bookcases³, and restrooms⁴ for boys and girls. In the school yard there are big shady trees and beautiful flower beds⁵. In the middle of the yard there is a flag.

Kady's classroom is in a new building. Its walls are painted with bright colors. It has four large windows and a big door. There are twenty-four tables for students, one big desk and a chair for the teacher. There is a chalkboard to write on. There is no clock in her classroom, but the bell rings at the beginning of each class. There are pictures and maps of Mali and of Africa on the walls. Kady's classroom is clean and comfortable. She likes it very much.
